



Community Friendship Café (Tower room):

The café remains open from at least 9am to 4pm weekdays, with the opportunity for visitors to serve themselves with refreshments whenever it is not manned. We currently need more volunteers to help run the café – training will be given and it is a very good way of meeting people. The internet is available to volunteers whilst on duty who bring their own pc.

We run a Beat Surgery with the local community police on a Saturday afternoon most months when the café is also open. Private conversations with police, if required, can take place in the church. The next surgery is 2.30-4.00pm on Saturday 7 September.
