The fees stated do not include digging the grave/plot or members of the Church attending the interment. These fees apply only where the interment is made between the hours of 10am and 4pm, not on Sundays or Bank Holidays.

Burial or other lawful disposal of cremated remains in a <b>cemeterly</b>	<b>128 increases to £141</b>

Small cross of wood	<b>34 increases to £38</b>
Small vase not exceeding 305mm by 203mm (12" x 8" x 8") or tablet, plaque or other marker commemorating a person whose remains have been cremated	<b>64 increases to £71</b>
Any other monument	<b>135 increases to £149</b>
Additional inscription to monument	<b>16 increases to £18</b>

Only residents who live within the Parish of Leigh on Mendip are entitled to be buried within the Leigh on Mendip Cemetery providing there is space available. Exceptional circumstances will be considered on an individual basis
