Quarry Overview

- So far in 2025, the total aggregate supplied from Halecombe is 395,000T
- The areas of the quarry that we will be focusing on are the faces to the south. Primarily benches 3, 4 & 5.
- The quarry continues to operate all Tarmac-owned equipment and directly employed personnel
- Primarily supply material to the asphalt plant on site, our own ready-mix concrete businesses in Wincanton and Bridgewater, as well as a variety of external customers locally.





Asphalt Overview

- So far in 2025, we have sold 199,000T of asphalt.
- Supplying a variety of projects across the south-west
- As with the quarry, our asphalt division operate Tarmac-owned equipment and personnel are all employed directly.
- We have started the process of readying the plant for an AI system (machine learning) to review our operating process, and recommend improvements to improve efficiency and reduce energy waste





- We have recently employed a new Quarry Manager – who starts with us in October 2025.
- In September 2024 we employed a new management apprentice – Patryk, who has now completed one year of University studies and work-based learning at Halecombe
- We have employed an apprentice electrician – Oliver – in September 2025 into our maintenance team to begin learning on the job and starting college studies.

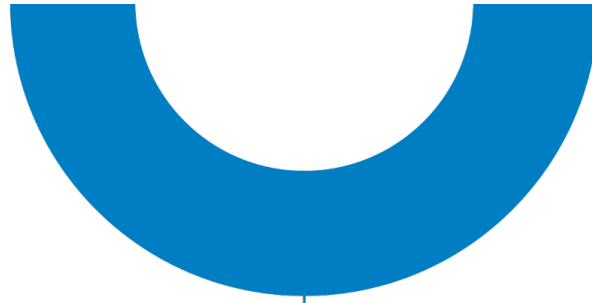
